
















Qualitative improvement has been the watchwords of both the Management and the faculty.





Studying at SDCH allows you to enjoy the best of both worlds - an excellent academic environment at the heart of one of the most cosmopolitan and exciting cities in north India.



OPD

The Dental Out Patient Department dovetails with the teaching facilities of the College. Besides providing oral health care to the patients, this facility works in tandem with the College of Dentistry.

The OPD has ultra modern, state-of-the-art equipment, all most all of it imported from the best manufacturers of the world. The apparatus and instruments include Modern Dental Units, RVG, Dental Implants, All Ceramic system, Orthoralix Cephalostat and OPG facilities, Intra Oral Camera, Light Cure Units, Ultrasonic Scalers, a sophisticated General Anaesthesia Operation Theater, as well as the latest dental materials.

The highly qualified and learned team of doctors and surgeons comprises of experts from various fields of dentistry. The entire team is dedicated to the task of bringing world class dental care to the people and contributing towards the health of the society at large.

Conservative Dentistry

The students are trained to have complete knowledge of aetiology, pathophysiology, diagnosis and management of dental carries, trauma, restorative and endodontic procedures. Students use advanced materials like composites, glass ionomers, varnishes and sealants, dentin bonding and light cure systems.

The department trains the students in endodontic procedures using advanced technologies like apex locators, radiovisiography and latest root canal obturation methods. Preclinical training comprising of simulated working on phantom heads is given to instill confidence for perfect restorative and endodontic procedures.

Prosthodontics

The prosthodontic graduate training programme imparts knowledge pertaining to restoration and maintenance of oral function, health, comfort and appearance by the replacement of missing and lost natural teeth. Students are trained on complete dentures, cast partial dentures, crown and bridge work, implant supported prosthesis through didactic and clinical learning. They undergo extensive training using state of the art modern equipment and material of International standards to enhance their preclinical skills. They also get trained in casting and ceramic work in the ceramo metal laboratory

Oral & Maxillofacial Surgery

Students are trained for extraction of teeth, local anaesthesia techniques, basic emergency training, management of medically compromised patients and complications that can occur during surgical procedures in the dental clinic. They are also trained to perform other minor oral surgical procedures under supervision, and are given a basic idea of different major oral and maxillofacial procedures. Emphasis is laid down on achieving sterile and aseptic conditions using state of the art and most advanced sterilization techniques.

Oral Medicine & Radiology

This department sits at the interface between dentistry and medicine and trains the novice dental student about oral health care of patients with chronic, recurrent and medically related disorders of the oral and maxillofacial region with their diagnosis and non surgical management. Oral and Maxillofacial Radiology is the speciality of dentistry and discipline of radiology concerned with the production and interpretation of images and data produced by all modalities of radiant energy that are used for the diagnosis and management of diseases, disorders and conditions of the oral and maxillofacial region.

Oral Pathology

Oral pathology is the discipline of pathology that deals with the nature, identification and management of diseases affecting the hard and soft tissue of oral and maxillofacial regions. The department trains students to perform routine histopathological evaluations along with haematological, cytological, microbiological, immunological and ultra structural investigations. The student is trained in the science of histology and pathology of oral and maxillofacial region utilizing state of the art digital microscopy and LCD projection system.

Pedodontics

Pediatric Dentistry is an age-defined speciality that provides comprehensive preventive and therapeutic oral health care for infants and children through adolescence, including those with special health care needs. Students are trained in aspects of child psychology, behaviour management, preventive dentistry, interceptive orthodontics, management of decayed teeth and traumatic injuries. They are trained in radiology pertaining to children, dental health education and school dental health programmes.

Periodontics

Periodontics encompasses the prevention, diagnosis and treatment of diseases of the supporting and surrounding tissues of the teeth. Students are trained in case analysis, treatment planning, maintenance, supportive and surgical periodontal therapy. Knowledge on techniques of muco-gingival surgeries, resective and reconstructive osseous surgeries and implantology is imparted to the students.

Orthodontics

The department trains students in immaculate history taking, methodological examination of patient, performing diagnostic procedures and management of dentofacial deformities. Students fabricate orthodontic appliances by conducting intricate wire bending procedures. The department imparts orthodontic treatment to a large percentage of the local population and the students of SDCH by the latest fixed orthodontic techniques including McLauglin, Benett, Traversy Technique. The department caters to cleft lip and palate rehabilitation by multidisciplinary approach. Orthognathic surgeries, distraction osteogenesis, implants and lingual orthodontics are some of the special interests of the department. The department regularly conducts extensive hands-on courses & continuing dental education programmes pertaining to the latest in the speciality.





Pharmacology

Pharmacology is a science that deals with assimilation, absorption, metabolism and excretion of drugs. The department imparts practical and clinical knowledge to students for choosing and use of drugs in order to achieve improved therapeutics. The department also undertakes various animal studies that can be extrapolated in the clinical settings helping in advancement of medical therapeutics.

General Pathology & Microbiology

Pathology is a bridging discipline involving both basic science and clinical practice and is devoted to the study of the structural and functional changes in cells, tissues and organs that underlie the disease. The department is well equipped with various molecular, microbiologic, immunologic and morphologic techniques to explain, why and wherefores of the signs and symptoms manifested by the patient, thus providing a sound foundation for rational clinical care and therapy.

Community Dentistry

The department disseminates knowledge and concept of health, emphasizing on public health problems, preventive dentistry, nutrition and environmental aspects related to dental health. It highlights on research methodology, biostatistics and health informatics. The student is trained to conduct community dental health programmes, school based dental health education and preventive methods. The department extends clinical care to nearby rural areas, with established satellite clinics in various villages adopted by the Institution.



General Human Anatomy

Thorough knowledge of General Human Anatomy is inculcated in students with special emphasis on head and neck by means of cadaver dissection and detailed study of hard and soft tissues of the human body. The department boasts of an excellent museum with life sized models and charts.

Physiology and Biochemistry

Physiology is concerned with specific characteristics and mechanisms of human body that makes it a living being. The department trains the student with a goal to explain the physical and chemical factors that are responsible for the origin, development and progression of life.

Biochemistry provides a sound knowledge of various biochemical reactions relevant to human system for life sustenance. The department has sufficient infrastructure and advanced equipment like colorimeter, pH meter, centrifuge machines, magnetic stirrer with hot plate, hot air oven, serological thermostat water bath, incubators, electronic balances, water distillation units, etc. Various biochemical tests performed on blood and urine samples, collected from healthy and diseased individuals make the student understand how it contributes in diagnosis, prognosis and treatment of disease.









General Medicine

The majority of medically compromised patients need oral health care; hence a working knowledge of the multitude of compromised conditions is essential for dental professionals. The curriculum during the 3rd professional year of BDS includes training in general medicine. The students acquire knowledge and skills of analyzing findings from patient's history, signs and symptoms. Special emphasis is placed on assessment of cardiovascular, endocrine, metabolic, respiratory, renal diseases and blood dyscrasias.

General Surgery

In general surgery students are familiarized with principles of general surgery and common general surgical procedures. Evaluation of patients for general anaesthetic techniques and management of emergencies along with intravenous sedation is taught. Seema Dental College is attached with 150 bedded General Government Hospital for giving live demo on patients to BDS students studying general surgery.



Continuing Dental Education





The Library


fulfills all the norms laid down by the Dental Council of India. It is housed in the multi-storeyed administrative building. It is brightly illuminated and comfortably furnished to contribute to the atmosphere required for concentrated study and for research work. Its shelves are well stacked with books and journals from various national and international publishing houses. The Library has been organised into separate reader services – namely, the main lending section, the text books section, the general reference section and a periodicals and journals section. The Library also offers the use of Computers along with Internet Services. A xerox machine room, a reading room with audio visual facilities, and an inter-departmental communication system, makes the library one of the best equipped in the region.

Digital Backbone

200 miles of computer cabling, gigabytes of data whizing from one terminal to the other, and precise monitoring of all activities in the campus – thats what the computer backbone at SDCH controls. The entire campus has been wired to be capable of being digitally controlled from the Computer Command Center. This nerve center controls everything from the telecommunications network to the management of patient data from the doctors' terminals. From the distribution of Internet Access to the distribution and allocation of background music at various public areas in the hospital.

5000 lines Siemens make telephone exchange with ISDN & Broad Band line facilities given by Telecom Department, BSNL is the highlight of the college.





Picture Perfect Professionalism



C ontinuous backup supply of electricity through two 380 KVA sound proof generators and non-stop flow of clean water by two separate underground water bores.







Admission Procedure for MDS

General

- Seema Dental College is permitted to admit 100 students for B.D.S. Course in each academic year.
- Admission to Govt. Quota Seats is through Uttarakhand PMT [conducted by the State Government].
- The admission to Management quota seats is through Common Pre Medical Entrance Exam (CPMEE) [In accordance with the guidelines / principles laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, an association of private colleges of Uttaranchal was formed known as Uttaranchal Council of Entrance Examination (UCEE).
- 7 The seats are filled through a merit list prepared on the basis of marks obtained in the Entrance examination.

Eligibility Criteria

The Candidate shall complete the age of 17 year on or before 31st December of the year of admission to the BDS course.

The candidate must have passed intermediate (10 + 2) or equivalent examination after a period of 12 years of study. The last two years of such study comprising of Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English from a recognised board / university and must have passed in all the above subjects.

Selection Criteria to BDS Course

The selection of candidate to Seema Dental College & Hospital shall be based solely on merit of the candidate.

Candidate for admission to BDS course must have passed in the subjects of Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English individually. And must have obtained a minimum of 50% marks taken together in the PCB at the qualifying examination. In respect of the candidates belonging to SC/ST/OBCs the marks obtained in Physics, Chemistry, Biology taken together in the qualifying examination be 40% in lieu of 50 % for general candidates.

The candidate appearing for State Govt. Seats shall qualify the eligibility criteria specified by the Uttarakhand Pre Medical test conducting body.

The All India candidates can appear in Common Pre Medical Entrance Exam (CPMEE). No domicile is required for the Management Quota Seats.

Instructions

- No refund of fee on withdrawal/cancellation of admission.
- The admission shall be considered cancelled if the student doesn't report to the college within the prescribed time.

- Appearing for the written test does not confer any right on the candidate to claim admission to the BDS Course.
- → The candidate who has appeared in the qualifying examination the result of which has not been declared, he can appear the entrance examination and in case of selection for admission to the BDS course, he shall not be admitted to the course until he fulfills the eligibility criteria.
- At the time of admission, the selected candidate has to fill an admission form and will be provided an instruction manual which is to be strictly followed during the stay at the college campus and during the course.
- In case the candidate fails to submit the required documents, admission shall be treated as cancelled and no request for refund of fees will be entertained. Decision of Principal of Seema Dental College will be final and binding.

Payment of Fee

- 1. Tuition Fee as per directive received from Govt. of India / Govt. of Uttarakhand.
- 2. College Fee as prescribed.
- 3. Examination Fee as prescribed.
- 4. Enrolment Fee as prescribed.
- 5. Fee from Failed Students: An extra fee will be charged per attempt per subject. The additional attempts may be due to detention, wilful absence or failure in any Professional examination.

All the fees are to be submitted at the time of admission. Dues, if any, for a session should be submitted before the end of that financial year i.e 31st March.

The fees for the next session should be deposited before the commencement of Professional Examination i.e. by 31st of July. Fees once paid shall not be refunded.

Uniform

The dress code for the boys and girls as prescribed is to be strictly followed.

Citizenship: Indian nationals can apply under the General Category. Foreign nationals or Non Resident Indians or Indian nationals supported by NRI relatives can apply under the Foreign/NRI Category.

To qualify under the NRI Category, candidates must be an NRI or supported by either Parents or Brothers or Sisters or Spouse having an NRI status.

Pass in BDS degree or equivalent degree recognized by Dental Council of India.

Internship

Candidates completing their compulsory rotating internship on or before 30th April are eligible.

Note: Candidates completing internship after 30th April are not eligible for admission in this academic year.

Registration

Candidates should have obtained permanent registration with Dental Council of India or any of the State Dental Council or should obtain the same within one month from the date of admission.

Admissions Procedure

The candidate will have to appear in an PG entrance examination either conducted by state Government for state quota or by the Association of private medical & dental colleges of Uttarakhand for management quota.
