




Seema Dental College and Hospital (SDCH) is committed to quality dental education and dental related health services with its motto "Service above self". The institution ensures to recruit and retain well qualified motivated faculty and staff and provides adequate infrastructure, equipment, and machinery for delivering the best dental service to the society.

The tobacco epidemic is one of the biggest public health threat the world has ever faced, killing more than 8 million people in a year including 1.2 million deaths from exposure to smoke. The need for capacity building is fundamental to implement tobacco control policies to stake of the tobacco epidemic. Training of health care professionals especially dentists is one the vital component as we come across people with this habit in our routine practice. Training and capacity building for tobacco control are undertaken by our training centre by organizing various courses/ workshops/ sensitization programmes namely celebration of World No Tobacco Day with events like marathon, awareness lecture, Nukad natak at public gathering etc as a part of these commemorative day celebration.

In aim to control the diseases occurring because of tobacco product usage, we need qualified trainers to serve the society to educate and help people to quit the habit and guide them in this process. The institute initially started with Tobacco cessation clinic in 9th March, 2016 and upgraded itself with Tobacco cessation training center in the year 2023. SDCH is the first institute in Uttarakhand which has established a Tobacco cessation training center in collaboration with ICan Care Pvt Ltd which is affiliated to Gujarat University. An MOU has been signed between SDCH and ICanCare Pvt Ltd and the tobacco cessation training center has been functional since 21st January 2023. The ICanCare has been aiding us in providing the capacity building for Uttarakhand Tobacco Cessation / Control training centre and offers us courses at three levels – Certified tobacco cessation specialist (CTCS-Tobacco cessation specialist), Orientation course in tobacco cessation (OCTC-Tobacco Ambassadors) and Basic course in Tobacco control (Tobacco Marhsals) which are recognized by Gujarat University.

Our faculty have been trained by ICan Care Pvt Ltd as certified tobacco cessation specialist and had completed Masters training in tobacco cessation(MTTC) from ICanCare, Gujarat University. Majority(45) of our faculties and post graduates have cleared Gujarat University Certified Orientation Course for Tobacco Cessation (OCTC) with higher grades and around 40 faculty, undergraduate and post graduate students have completed Marshal Training basic Certificate Course conducted in our college in collaboration with ICanCare. With our own faculty a certified tobacco cessation specialist, the institute has conducted various training programmes like tobacco marshal programme, basic training in Tobacco cessation in our TCC Training center in association with ICanCare to volunteers, health care professionals, Government health sector





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
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officials like UTFC, etc. The programmes cover the entire knowledge on tobacco cessation and other field which the participants will learn in the course and these trained professionals can serve the society to eradicate tobacco usage which is a contribution by SDCH for society upliftment.



Tobacco cessation training centre in the Institution











Tobacco cessation training offered to UTFC members by the Institution TCC Training centre

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

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

Objective -Implement best practice patient screening and care procedures, Demonstrate understanding of best practices and complications related to tobacco cessation, Identify multiple treatment plans, techniques and available resources to offer as patient care, provide patient education on new and emerging tobacco products, evaluate the effectiveness of the treatment being offered.

Expected Outcome: Goal is to train interdisciplinary health care providers and public health professionals to become tobacco cessation champions for their organizations and communities. This was whole day program with the following learning objectives: Implement best practice patient screening and care procedures, Demonstrate understanding of best practices and complications related to tobacco cessation, Identify multiple treatment plans, techniques and available resources to offer as patient care, provide patient education on new and emerging tobacco products, evaluate the effectiveness of the treatment being offered

Outcome Achieved: The program was conducted to enhance theoretical and practical knowledge of tobacco use and factors influencing it. Assessing the severity of tobacco addiction by using an objective scale, practicing basic counselling, communication skills and psychosocial intervention to prevent relapse was discussed. Prescribing over the counter Nicotine replacement therapy and knowledge about other pharmacotherapy and decision making about what can be managed by them and what needs to be referred to. In this, training participants have learnt more about nicotine addiction and how to integrate brief, evidence –based tobacco treatment interventions into current practice. In this, training participants also learnt about tobacco prevalence, products and burden, e-cigarettes and vaping, motivational interviewing, how to integrate brief, evidence based tobacco treatment interventions into current practice, tobacco treatment medications and relapse prevention an recovery. These training were approved by Tobacco Treatment Specialist done by ICanCare affiliated to Gujarat University.

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"World No Tobacco Day Report 2024"

(15 days Activity from 20-05-2024 to 05-06-2024)

Theme: Protecting Children from Tobacco Industry Interferences
Seema Dental College & Hospital, Rishikesh



Content:

World no tobacco Day is celebrated every year and this year WNTD 2024 gave a platform to young people across the world, who are urging governments to shield them from predatory tobacco marketing tactics. The industry targets youth for a lifetime of profits, creating a new wave of addiction. Children are using e-cigarettes at rates higher than adults in all regions and globally an estimated 37 million youth aged 13-15 years use tobacco. Young people globally are calling on governments to adopt policies that shield them for manipulative practices of tobacco and related industries, including the relentless marketing of their dangerous products through social media and streaming platforms.

Executive Summary:

Introduction:

Tobacco is the only legal consumer product that kills up to half of its users when used exactly as intended by the manufacturer. Tobacco companies spent over 8 billion dollars on marketing and advertising. Children and adolescents who use e-cigarettes at least double their chance of smoking cigarettes later in life.

Finding:

Young people around the world recognize the industry's negative impact on issues they care about: physical and mental health, sustainability, plastics pollution, environmental devastation and climate change, child labour, poverty and inequity.

Objective:

Youth groups around the world can urge their governments to implement measures to prevent tobacco use and nicotine addiction. They can call for tobacco corporations to be held accountable and financially liable for past, present and future harms caused by their activities. To raise awareness and harms caused by tobacco products

Recommendation:

Governments should implement the WHO FCTC, including:

- ❖ Implementing and enforcing comprehensive TAPS bans and the specific guidelines to address cross-border advertising, promotion and sponsorship and the depiction of tobacco in entertainment media for implementation of Article 13, adopted at COP 10 in February 2024.
- * Raising prices and taxes on tobacco and nicotine products to make them less affordable.
- ❖ Banning sales of these products to children
- ❖ Implementing Article 5.3 to protect policy from industry influence.

Conclusion:

Governments should hold the tobacco and related industries accountable, including imposing financial penalities, for:

- Breaches of national TAPS laws
- ❖ The harm they cause to health and the environment
- ❖ The health, environmental, economic costs associated with the production, marketing and use of the industry's products.
- * Their descriptive marketing and other corporate practices that undermine public health and environmental policies.

Activity 1: Promotive, preventive and screening outreach activities

Department of Public Health Dentistry conducted various promotive, preventive and screening outreach activities on the occasion of "World no tobacco Day-2024". All treatments were provided free of cost, which included oral cavity examination, oral health talk, oral hygiene instructions, tooth restorations, oral prophylaxis and tooth extractions. Patients were referred to Seema dental college & Hospital, Rishikesh for further treatment.

A lecture was held by Dr. Jyotsna Seth, Professor, Prosthodontics, at Pt. Lalit Mohan Pg college on 27.05.2024. On the occasion of World No Tobacco Day 31st May 2024, Seema Dental College and Hospital, Rishikesh organized a poster making competition, flex designing competition and 3D model making competition. 3rd year BDS students came first in poster making and flex designing competition and 4th year BDS students won 3D model making competition. Dr. Amit Gupta, Chairman, SDCH, Dr. P. Narayana Prasad, Principle, SDCH and Dr. Preeti Bali, MD in Anaesthesia, distributed the prizes and certificates to the winners and appreciated all the participants. Dr. Kalpana Chaudhary, Dr. Varun Kumar and Dr. Tarun Sharma were the judges of the above competition.

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Camp 1: On 23.05.2024, a dental camp was organised by department of Public health dentistry at Valmiki Nagar, Rishikesh. A total of 94 patients got benefitted, 11 extractions, 41 oral prophylaxis & 18 Restoration were done. Patients with major dental needs were referred to Seema Dental College and Hospital. The remaining required treatment will be provided for these registered camp patients in the college.

Camp 2: On 24.05.2024, a dental camp was organised by department of Public health dentistry at Pragati Vihar, Rishikesh. A total of 60 patients got benefitted, 32 oral prophylaxis & 09 Restoration were done. Patients with major dental needs were referred to Seema Dental College and Hospital. The remaining required treatment will be provided for these registered camp patients in the college

camp 3: On 27.05.2024, a dental camp was organised by department of Public health dentistry at Pt. Lalit Mohan Sharma PG College, Rishikesh. A total of 57 patients got benefitted, 22 oral prophylaxis & 05 Restoration were done. Patients with major dental needs were referred to Seema Dental College and Hospital. The remaining required treatment will be provided for these registered camp patients in the college.

Activity 2 : IEC Activities

IEC is one of the major components of the National Tobacco Control Programme. Nation-wide IEC or public awareness campaigns have also been launched in the print and electronic media for dissemination of various provisions of the Act. This included publicity in national and regional newspapers, private and Government Radio & TV channels and dissemination of publicity materials such as posters, stickers, handouts, factsheets etc. Dedicated spots have been developed as well as adopted from the global best practices. The Campaigns are aired through the Government as well as Private Channels for both video/TV as well as radio/FM. Accordingly, there is also provision of dedicated funds for carrying out IEC activities at State/district level.

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Activity 3: Oral Cancer Screening Activities

Free oral cancer screening camp were organized by Ganga Prem Hospice on every last Sunday of the month. Collaboration with Ganga Prem Hospice, Rishikesh Seema Dental College & Hospital team including Dr. Jyotsna Seth, Dr. S Prasanna and Dr. Anushree joined GPH team to screen oral cancer patients on 26th May, 2024.

The main aim was to raise awareness about oral cancer and promote oral health. By these camps we have typically provide free oral cancer screening, dental checkup etc. During these camps, out trained healthcare professionals who have also done palliative care course, perform a visual and physical examination of the oral cavity to look for signs of cancer. From this camp they were referred for further treatment or follow-up care if necessary. This camp was organized by Ganga Prem Hospice under the able guidance of Dr. AK Dewan one of the leading Oncologists and Director Surgical Oncology at Rajiv Gandhi Cancer Institute & RC and Dr. Taranjit Singh Lead Onco Specialist working in Ganga Prem Hospice. Patients were screened and IEC materials were distributed among the patients approached in this monthly oral cancer awareness camp.

Overall, this camp was a valuable resource for individuals who may not have regular access to oral health care or who may be at risk for oral cancer. These camps help to identify dental issues early on, which can lead to better outcomes and lower costs in the long term.

Miss Mamta Thapa, Dr. Pawan Gupta Founder and Master Trainer for Tobacco Cessation- ICanCare Academy, Dr. S Karpagavalli Certified CTCS, Dr. Avnish Singh Certified CTCS and Dr. Jyotsna Seth, Certified Tobacco Cessation Specialist delivered their lectures in the training program. The Management felicitated Dr. Aditya, State Nodal Officer, NTCP, Mr. Prem Taneja, Chairman, UTFC and Mr. Awadesh Kumar, Executive Director, BSS and congratulated the participants who cleared this basic training of tobacco cessation.

Activity 5: School Based tobacco Control And cessation initiatives

School-based cessation programs focus on supporting students in their efforts to quit using tobacco products. These programs can teach students refusal skills and avoidance techniques, provide social support from peers and counsellors, and link participants to resources in the community.

These school-based camps were done to implement seven recommendations to effectively prevent tobacco use among youth:

- 1. Create school policies around tobacco use
- 2. Educate students on the negative physiological and social effects of tobacco use.
- 3. Integrate tobacco prevention education for all students, with a focus on junior high and middle school grades.
- 4. Offer special training to educators and other program facilitators.
- 5. Engage parents in tobacco prevention efforts.
- 6. Offer tobacco cessation support to students and staff.
- 7. Consistently evaluate tobacco prevention programs.

An effective TCC aims to provide I) Patient care services and II) Community awareness.

I). Patient care services:

All Pharmacological treatment protocol is followed according to internationally accepted standard guidelines. Nicotine gum and nicotine lozenges and pharmacological drugs are prescribed and given by the councilors in our Tobacco Cessation Centre. Cold Turkey method is also followed in some patients for cessation of tobacco usage.



PRINCIPAL



The patients are counseled by Health professionals in Tobacco Cessation Centre by means of audio-visual and printed media. The patients are shown motivational videos and adversely affected tobacco related pictures of patients with lesions.





The health professional follows behavioral counseling of those patients who are -

Willing to quit by the 5 "A" Methods	Unwilling to quit by the 5 "R" Methods

II) Community awareness:

a) Undergraduate dental students of 3rd & 4th year & interns along with health workers and paramedical staff are trained in identifying tobacco users & dependent patients and are also trained in providing counseling to such patients.





- b) SDCH organizes several camps, rallies, nukkad natak, No Tobacco Oath Ceremony, Each one Teach one, etc and Educational & Motivational Lectures which includes awareness regarding Tobacco Cessation.

SDCH also conducts Free Screening for tobacco users and Educational Lectures on De-addiction. 

- g) For the dental treatments the patients are referred to the respective departments and the rehabilitation programs are conducted in the Tobacco Cessation Centre itself for all the patients enrolled in Cessation Centre.
- h) The data is gathered in registers manually and in soft copy and disseminate by creating a data bank with all the relevant information.
- i) The college faculties conduct research on tobacco users, its addictions and its dependency. The data collected in TCC is available to all faculties of the institution who so ever requires it for their scientific studies.

Organization and Administration:


PRINCIPAL

- a) The Tobacco Cessation Centre in Seema Dental College & Hospital is under the Department of Public health Dentistry and all the tobacco users are referred mainly from Department of Oral Medicine and Radiology to TCC and from TCC they are referred to respective departments for further treatments. And the patients from all departments are also referred to TCC.
- b) The Center operates on daily basis with a monthly schedule of staff along with interns.

- c) Cleared structural protocol, performing individual and optionally group counseling along with community based programs and record keeping is followed on regular basis.
- d) The individual patient counseling sessions are scheduled and the appointments are given accordingly.
- e) The group sessions are planned and performed on the designated/scheduled days.

- f) An updated organization chart and a clear job description for each Center employee are followed thoroughly.
- g) The Center has linkages with the dental departments in SDCH and with AIIMS hospital Rishikesh. The referral pathway is shown in flow-chart and all the dental departments are sensitized regularly. All the Dental Departments are referring patients who are identified as Tobacco users.

Tobacco Cessation Centre Floor Plan:

The TCC is located on the ground floor in the institute near the reception area and is also near to Oral Medicine & Radiology Department. The centre has designated areas for individual counseling and Optional Group Sessions are conducted in Oral Health Education room. There is adequate space for maintaining medical records along with comfortable seating arrangements and is free from external sounds. TCC has sufficient space for display of posters and IEC materials and has the provision for electrical supply, telephone and internet facilities and has attached toilet and drinking water facilities.
