MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU)

This memorandum of understanding (MOU) is for cooperation in health education, research and service fields for developing a collaborative arrangement, whereby the Institutions may participate in collaborative teaching, training, research and other agreed activities to further enhance relationship between two Institutions.

This MOU is entered between:

All India Institute of Medical Sciences, Rishikesh, situated at Virbhadr Marg, Pashulok, Rishikesh-249203, Uttarakhand, India (herein after referred as "AIIMS Rishikesh"), (An autonomous Institution constituted as an Institute of National Importance through an Act of Parliament under Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Govt. of India) acting through **Authorized Representative**, which expression shall, unless repugnant to the context, include its successor, administrators, assigns or legal representatives on one part

And

Seema Dental College & Hospital, Rishikesh, Uttarakhand (hereinafter "SDCH"), (A unit of Dr. B. S. Gupta Medical Charitable Society, Rishikesh, Uttarakhand and recognized by Government of India, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare & affiliated to H.N.B. Garhwal University (Central University), Srinagar, Garhwal) through **Authorized Representative**, which expression shall, unless repugnant to the context, include its successor, administrators, assigns or legal representatives.

Both institutions state that they:

Recognize the value of academic interchange and lively engagement in an international scholarly community by members of academic and research institution.

Discern the significance and importance of collaboration in the pursuit of international cooperation and awareness by each institute's interest in and need for establishing and sustaining such cooperative ties.


Confirm the significance of the furthering of knowledge and the creative role of the international scholarly communication and collaboration in the development and dissemination of learning and research.

Hence, in the spirit of promoting exchanges between them in all pertinent area of health education, research, and service, both the institutions **agree as follows:**

A. General Objectives

- i. To exchange information, articles, reports and teaching materials in order to support the educational programs of each institution in the field of the Professional Competencies (particularly the areas of Communication Skills, Ethics, Professionalism, Self-Care and Self-Awareness)







- ii. To strengthen and encourage communication and collaboration in education and research between members of the two institutions, particularly with respect to the Professional Competencies program.
- iii. To stimulate contacts between investigators in health science from the two institutions.
- iv. To develop academic projects such as collaborative research, teaching, technical cooperative, evaluation and publication. The human and technical resources which will contribute in designing and operating the program shall be specified from each institution. Also, the mechanism and action to evaluate, supervise and utilize the products of the aforementioned programs, shall be jointly established.
- v. To promote bilateral co-operation in scientific research and education in different faculties involving:
 - a. Teaching and exchange of scientific researchers
 - b. Organizing lecture, seminars and scientific meetings
 - c. Development of projects of common interest
 - d. Visits of faculty and students for the mutual benefits of both institutions
 - e. Co-operation in conduct of research (except finances).

B. Scholar Exchange and Education Collaboration

- i. To develop learning opportunities through courses, seminars workshops, and other means from both institutions to pursue activities related to scholars' academic program, particularly with respect to the development of a Professional Competencies curriculum adapted for use at respective institution.
- ii. To facilitate visit by medical students between institutions vice versa who will assist with the roll-out of the Professional Competencies curriculum, as well as participating in clinical electives. In addition, to facilitate visits by students from other related disciplines (such as Global Health or Nursing), as required for the implementation and evaluation of the Professional Competencies program.
- iii. To facilitate the exchange of health science faculty members and visiting scholars dedicated to participating in teaching and research.
- iv. In all cases, the exchange of faculty members and visiting scholars will occur within the regulation of each institution and will take place on an individual basis.

C. Legal Conditions

- i. This MOU is a statement of intent and in no way intended to create legal or binding obligation on either Institution and serves only as a record of the institutions' current intention to enhance the



relationship of the Institution going forward. This MoU does not create legally enforceable rights claim, interest, duty, or obligation in favour of either of the party as against other party.

- ii. All co-operation is on self-finance basis and non of the institutions is obliged to support each other financially for the purpose of this MOU.
- iii. The Institutions agree to designate the following person as administrative focal point for any administrative aspects for this MOU:

a) For **AIIMS Rishikesh**





- iv. All students and faculty exchanges will be approved at the departmental and faculty level through the appropriate mechanisms as per defined procedures.
- v. For the purpose of coordinating visits, correspondence and projects, exchange visitors will communicate with a counterpart in the institutions where cooperative research or teaching occurs.
- vi. All risk procedures within the policy structure as defined by concerned institution will be carried out and reported on before any exchanges take place.
- vii. Before any particular cooperative project or program is initiated, all financial detail shall be negotiated specially allocation to effect by administration authorities. Notwithstanding anything contained in this MOU, each institution will remain responsible for their own initiative in level of finance.
- viii. Cooperative projects requiring financial support shall not be initiated in the expectation of support by either institution before such funding has been explicitly agreed to and committed by written consent and a further agreement would be required.
- ix. This MOU shall come into effect for a period of ten (10) years upon the signature of both parties and shall be renewed with their mutual consent and signature. It may be extended by written agreement of both partners.
- x. In case of any dispute or difference relating to this MOU, both parties agree to resolve the same through mediation before going to arbitration or litigation.





- xi. Either party may terminate this MOU with six months advance written notice to the other party. Competent courts in Uttarakhand shall have exclusive jurisdiction.
- xii. Such termination shall not affect the validity of any agreement already made under terms of Executive Agreement.
- xiii. Both parties of this MOU agree to act in good faith and in a spirit of mutual understanding and accommodation to facilitate achievement of goals set under this MOU.

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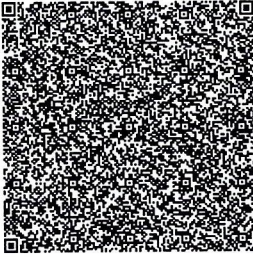

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU)

THIS MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING ("herein after referred as MOU") is made on 18th day of December, 2017, between Seema Dental College & Hospital, Rishikesh, Uttarakhand (hereinafter "SDCH"), (A unit of Dr. B. S. Gupta Medical Charitable Society, Rishikesh, Uttarakhand and recognized by Government of India, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare & affiliated to H.N.B. Garhwal University (Central University), Srinagar, Garhwal) on one part; and

All India Institute of Medical Sciences, situated at Virbhadr Marg, Pashulok, Rishikesh-249203, Uttarakhand, India (herein after referred as "AIIMS"), (An autonomous Institution of Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Govt. of India)

WHEREAS both SDCH and AIIMS Rishikesh, (hereinafter collectively referred to as "Parties" or "Institutions."

WHEREAS SDCH and AIIMS Rishikesh agree to enter into clinical training program and both parties agree to enter into MOU with terms as follows:

1.0. Purpose of MOU:


The primary objective of this MOU is to create a means for cooperative efforts between **SDCH** with **AIIMS** Rishikesh for providing clinical training to BDS III Year Students of SDCH in subjects of Medicine & Surgery, and MDS II Year Students (of Oral Medicine & Radiology and Oral Pathology) in Department of Dermatology, Radiology, Medicine, Surgery, Oncology & E.N.T. at AIIMS by faculty of AIIMS.

For purpose this MOU, AIIMS Rishikesh agrees to assist in providing necessary knowledge and shall provide platform for clinical training subject to rules and regulations governing guidelines for this association thereon to be complied by **SDCH** as per DCI/University Curriculum.

SDCH also agrees to ensure all co-operation for imparting all training etc. as may be required for students of AIIMS Rishikesh relating to its dental curriculum.

2.0. Scope of MOU:

The BDS & MDS students of SDCH will get available clinical/medical training facilities at AIIMS, Rishikesh. The clinical training of BDS & MDS students of SDCH at AIIMS will help to produce quality dental professionals, who can deliver their services in field of oral health and medical care at par with international standards and can serve society for better health care.



SDCH also undertakes to ensure all co-operation for imparting all training etc. as may be required for students of AIIMS Rishikesh as per requirements of AIIMS Rishikesh.

3.0. Areas & Terms of Collaboration:

With reference to SDCH letter # SDCH/PO/DP-195/2017/249 dated 27/10/2017, AIIMS Rishikesh is pleased to affiliate SDCH for providing clinical training to BDS III Year Students and MDS II Year students (of Oral Medicine & Radiology and Oral Pathology) of SDCH, Rishikesh in Medical Subjects as per DCI/University Curriculum and areas of potential collaboration between Parties in fields of clinical training shall include and be limited to:

Clinical Training to BDS III Year Students

(i) Students of BDS III Year (annual intake 100 students) of SDCH will be provided clinical training (IPD/OPD) at Department of Medicine and Surgery as per DCI/University Curriculum (details of syllabus attached as **Annexure-1**) under supervision of faculty of AIIMS, Rishikesh.

(ii) In order to provide systematic clinical training to BDS III Year Students of SDCH at Department of Medicine & Surgery, AIIMS Rishikesh, timetable of required clinical postings shall be made by Director Principal of SDCH in consultation with HODs of respective departments of AIIMS Rishikesh under the intimation of Dean, AIIMS Rishikesh.

(iii) Every year, academic session of SDCH commences from 1st September to 31st July, however, BDS III Year Students of SDCH will be sent to AIIMS for their clinical training at Department of Medicine and Surgery from 1st Oct. to 30th June, five days (Mon. to Friday) in a week. For each academic session, names and number of BDS III Year Students will be provided by Director Principal SDCH to Dean AIIMS and their clinical posting schedule will be prepared and finalized with mutual consent of both every year, before commencement of clinical posting.

However, for current academic session 2017-2018, BDS III Year Students will be posted in Department of Medicine & Surgery, AIIMS for only six months from 1st Jan. 2018 to 30th June 2018. For current academic session 2017-2018, clinical posting schedule will be prepared and finalized with mutual consent of Director Principal

SDCH and Dean AIIMS, Rishikesh before commencement of clinical posting, i.e. w.e.f. 1st Jan. 2018.

(iv) The attendance record of BDS III Year Students of SDCH posted in Department of Medicine and Surgery, AIIMS shall be maintained by faculty of respective Departments of AIIMS and at end of their posting, attendance details of BDS III Year Students of SDCH will be handed over to Director Principal Office, SDCH in first week of July in every academic session.

(v) Department of Medicine & Surgery, AIIMS will provide all necessary facilities for conducting Practical/Clinical Exam (Internal Assessments held in months of Feb. & July) and University Practical/Clinical Exam of BDS III Year Students in subjects of General Medicine & General Surgery by approved examiners (External/internal examiners) of H.N.B. Garhwal University, Srinagar.

(vi) The BDS III Year Students of SDCH will be required to maintain decorum in AIIMS and will be bound to follow Rules & Regulations of Department/Institute. While posting of BDS III Year Students of SDCH at Department of Medicine & Surgery, AIIMS, if any student is found offender of any Rules & Regulations of Department/Institute, AIIMS authority shall report matter to Director Principal of SDCH for appropriate disciplinary action to be taken against defaulter. However, in case of serious violation of any Rules & Regulations of Department/Institute, AIIMS authority can take appropriate action at their level.

(vii) On days of clinical posting, BDS III Year Students of SDCH will report to Department of Medicine & Surgery, AIIMS, Rishikesh along with a faculty/staff and a caretaker, who will be responsible for counting numbers of students at time of departure from SDCH and reaching back to SDCH.

Notwithstanding, anything contained in this MOU, support offered by AIIMS Rishikesh shall be only to extent of facilities available in Institute.

Clinical Training to MDS II Year Students

(viii) MDS II Year Students (3 students of Oral Medicine & Radiology and 3 students Oral Pathology) will be provided 10 days clinical training in each Department of Dermatology, Radiology, Medicine, Surgery, Oncology and E.N.T. (total 60 days clinical posting) as per DCI/University Curriculum under supervision of AIIMS





Rishikesh faculty. For each academic session, schedule of posting and names of MDS II Year Students will be provided by Director Principal SDCH to Dean AIIMS before commencement of posting.

(ix) The MDS II Year Students of SDCH will be required to maintain decorum in AIIMS and will be bound to follow Rules & Regulations of Department/Institute. While posting of MDS II Year Students of SDCH at different Departments of AIIMS, if any student is found offender of any Rules & Regulations of Department/Institute, AIIMS authority shall report matter to Director Principal of SDCH for appropriate disciplinary action to be taken against defaulter. However, in case of serious violation of any Rules & Regulations of Department/Institute, AIIMS authority can take appropriate action at their level.

4.0. Finance:

Regarding financial agreement during MOU implementation, SDCH and AIIMS Rishikesh further agree that for providing above mentioned services, SDCH, Rishikesh will pay rupees seven lakh (Rs 7,00,000/-) per annum to AIIMS Rishikesh.

The annual sum as payable under this MOU has to be deposited with AIIMS Rishikesh by SDCH before starting of each session of BDS i.e; on or before month of September each academic year except for the current academic year in which case, it is to be deposited in the month of December 2017.

AIIMS Rishikesh is not required to pay any sum to SDCH for getting its students trained at SDCH.

5.0. Indemnity:

SDCH hereby undertakes to indemnify and shall keep indemnified and protected AIIMS Rishikesh and its officers and employees from and against any loss/damage or claims or actions arising out of or in any way related to provision and implementation of this MOU.

6.0. Duration & Amendment:

Unless otherwise terminated, this MOU will be active for a period of five years from date of MOU mentioned in front page. It can be extended for further period by mutual consent.





This MOU may be modified or amended by mutual consent of Parties.

7.0. Termination:

Notwithstanding anything contained in para 6 about duration of this MOU, either party has right to terminate this MOU by giving ninety (90) days written notice before expiry of any academic session at SDCH to other party without any obligation as to damage, loss or cessation of any business opportunity to SDCH.

It is responsibility of each party to notify other in writing if there are any needed changes in this MOU or if MOU needs to be terminated.

8.0. Dispute Resolution & Jurisdiction:

In event of any dispute arising out of this MOU, decision of Director AIIMS, Rishikesh will be final and binding upon both parties.

The competent courts in Rishikesh, Uttarakhand shall alone have an exclusive jurisdiction.

Both parties of this MOU agree to act in good faith and in a spirit of mutual understanding and accommodation to facilitate achievement of goals set under this MOU.

This MOU is executed in two copies, each to be retained by respective parties to form one and single document.


